SUMMARY:

The purpose of the project is to design (including environmental compliance) full water tank replacement, and provide construction for roughly 1,630 feet of new 8-inch distribution waterline, gate valve, infiltration basin, connections to the existing distribution system, all associated appurtenances, and site restoration/erosion control.

The project will be done as 2 Phases, however funding is only available for Phase 1. The first Phase will consist of designing the new tank and construction of roughly 1,630 feet of new 8-inch distribution waterline. Once funding is secured, Phase 2 will include demo of the existing water tank and construction of the new 450,000-gallon water storage tank.

The community benefit would be to ensure adequate water distribution and storage for the village of Cuba

The project is expected to begin construction May 2026 and to be completed October 2026.
