Roadwork begins on US 550 in Cuba
Expect lane closures and minor delays

MILAN – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Six along with Siete Inc (Contractor) began a \$14.9 million bridge replacement project in Cuba, NM.

Work began August 25, 2025, on the southbound lanes at mile marker 64. All traffic has been diverted onto the northbound lanes for the first phase of the project. Contractor's work hours are scheduled from 7am to 7pm, Monday through Friday.

Drivers should expect lane closures, minor delays and plan travel accordingly.
